The regular meeting of the South Connellsville Municipal Authority was called to order by President George Jay in Council Chambers convening at 6:00 pm. Those present were: George Jay, Jeff Addis, and Tom Jenkins. Also in attendance: Secretary Kelly Addis, Treasurer Elizabeth Giles, Engineer Kerry Bell, Street Department Foreman Matt Bartholomai and Solicitor Tim Witt. Absent: James Piper

**READING OR WAIVING OF MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING:** Tom Jenkins made a motion to waive the reading of the previous minutes for May. Second by Jeff Addis. All in favor. Motion carried.

**HEARING OF CITIZEN'S & VISITORS:** Nothing at this time.

**COMMUNICATIONS:** Secretary Kelly Addis stated that the 2025 Municipal Authority Audit will be started the week of July 13<sup>th</sup>.

**PAYMENT OF BILLS:** Tom Jenkins made a motion to accept and pay the June bills. Second by Jeff Addis. All in favor. Motion carried.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:** George Jay stated that we need to discuss and make a motion to seek bids for the Reidmore Road sewer project. Engineer Kerry Bell said that we have \$200,000 in grant money from PA Small Water program. Kerry will submit for permit this week and we will get the project out for bid as soon as we get the permit from the DEP. Bids will be accepted through Monday, July 13<sup>th</sup> at 3:00pm. Tom Jenkins made a motion to seek bids for the Reidmore Road Sewage project, contingent on the DEP street crossing permit and will be due in the borough office by Monday, July 13<sup>th</sup> at 3:00pm to be opened at the 6:00 Municipal Authority meeting. Second by George Jay. All in favor. Motion carried. George Jay made a motion to move the fence at the pump station to make room for a new carport to house the new leaf vac. Second by Jeff Addis. All in favor. Motion carried.

**NEW BUSINESS:** George Jay made a motion to amend the agenda to include a motion for the MAWC right-of-way down at the sewage plant. Second by Tom Jenkins. All in favor. Motion carried. George Jay made a motion to approve the Westmoreland Water to install a new manhole and a new section of storm sewer and get an easement to bring their waterline up in the areas that they have marked down there, contingent on Solicitor/Engineer approval. Second by Tom Jenkins. All in favor. Motion carried.
